WHAT IS THE MEMORIAL WALL?

The Memorial Wall provides a living and loving memorial for those named. Its funding supports the church gardens.

WHAT DOES THE DESIGN OF THE WALL REPRESENT?

The cross is central to the design with other Christian symbols represented in the passion vine and flowers that entwine and flow from the cross. The pomegranate and butterflies symbolize eternal life.

WHO CAN BE MEMORIALIZED?

The Tanque Verde Lutheran Church community and their families and loved ones can be memorialized.

WHEN ARE TILES ADDED?

Tiles are ordered and installed after purchase.

CAN I BUY A TREE OR PLANT INSTEAD?
